And in the space of a week, we are 1 client away from running at capacity! Again, we take no pleasure 'finding' a client in debt, but we do take so much job satisfaction from being able to make a difference in the lives of the people we support. This again can take many shapes and forms as we not only offer debt advice but CAP, as an organisation, have ongoing money courses run by our partnership churches. The money course being a practical avenue to help us budget better and keep a watchful eye over our own finances which is extremely helpful!
